

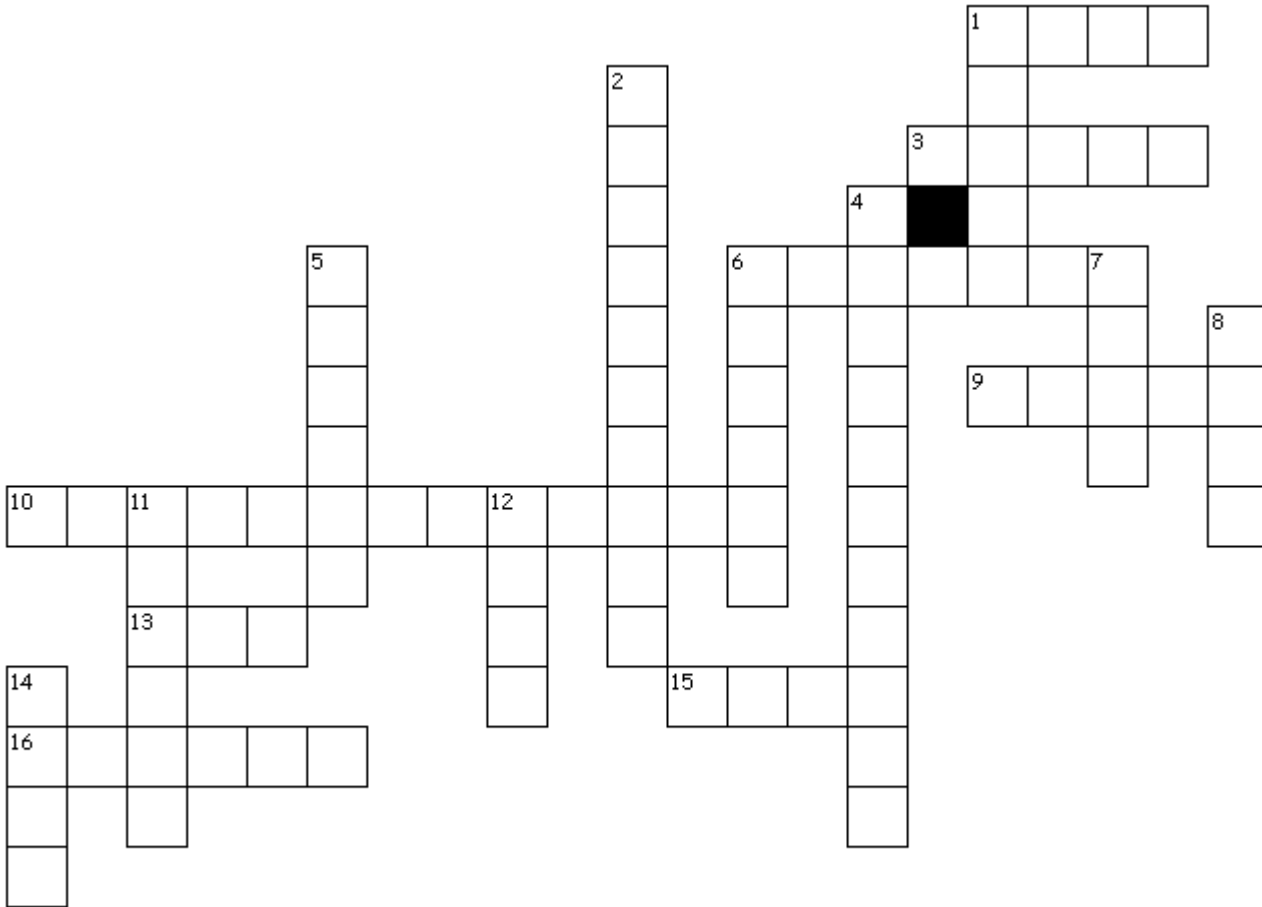

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# Spinning and Weaving



## Across

1. the weaving threads that go through the warp threads
3. a plain weave- over one and under one
6. the part of the loom that holds the heddles
9. a weave that makes a diagonal pattern
10. a basic machine used to make spinning easier
13. substance used to give color to fibers
15. the part of the loom that the beater holds to keep the threads straight
16. hair from an angora rabbit

## Down

1. interlacing threads together to form a cloth by two perpendicular sets of thread
2. small bug used to make red dye
4. a small top like tool used for spinning
5. hair from an angora goat
6. the part of the loom that the warp threads go through so that they can be lifted up to form a pattern in the weave
7. process of twisting fibers together to make a long strand
8. a plant that is used to make linen
11. a plant grown to make a blue dye (or the dye itself)
12. hair from sheep
14. the threads that run lengthwise through the heddles in a loom
