Edwardian Day Camp Lets Girls Step Back to Statehood Days

Hitchcock, OK, May 3, 2007 – This summer, Shooting Star Enterprises will host two five-day, historical day camps for young ladies who will be entering the 3rd through 6th grades (about ages 8-13) in the upcoming school year. New this year will be an additional camp that will be all day July 16-18 as well. The event will be held from 9 a.m. through 2 p.m. each day at the Shooting Star's facilities in Hitchcock, Oklahoma. The first session runs from June 25-29, 2007; and the second session runs from July 23-27, 2007. The goal: to immerse the young ladies in turn-of-the-century life by encouraging grace, manners, and creativity with a historical perspective.

The event, "Oklahoma Girls- An Edwardian Day Camp", focuses on the years 1904-1907, which is perfect for girls who love the American Girls® Samantha Series™ or for those who are preparing for the statehood events in 2007. Each participant will learn turn-of-the-century dance, plain and fancy sewing, basics of cooking and teatime manners, as well as do historical crafts and play both indoor and outdoor period games. Plus, Marna Jean Davis, historical clothing expert and hostess of the festivities, will provide costumes for the girls to wear during the camp, so that they can truly feel like they are a part of history.

Marna Jean Davis is a Living Historian and Historical Clothing Designer residing on her family farm in Hitchcock, Oklahoma with her husband Doug, two daughters age 3 and 9. She has worked with children for many years in prestigious museums such as the Buffalo Bill Historic Center in Cody, Wyoming in addition to local schools and museums. It has delighted her to watch her 8 year old become caught up in the history of "Samantha", which prompted her decision to open their home to other young ladies with similar interests. Doug and Marna Jean have a museum right in their home, where both the young and old alike can come to learn a bit more about history.
